ESSAY PROMPT & REQUIREMENTS

Students will write an essay that begins with "I am lucky because." Students should use their own words and creativity when answering the prompt. Students should handwrite the essay in legible handwriting in pen or pencil. The essay will be nonfiction and must be school-appropriate.

In order to be eligible for the essay contest and prize:

- 1. The student must be of early elementary age and grade level of 1st-3rd grade
- 2. The essay submission must include: student name, student birthday, home phone number, and parent signature
- 3. Be a resident of IL or WI

PRIZES IN EACH AGE CATEGORY

The judges will select one prize winner in each category based on both the content and correct use of writing conventions. Judges will look for writing that is clear, easy to understand, and legible. Only one entry per student will be judged. The essay must be solely the work of the entrant.
